Kevin Nordmeyer brings more than 25 years of highly relevant leadership and design experience to the profession. He has served as a pioneer in sustainable design in Iowa, leading the creation of Iowa's first sustainable buildings in the mid-1990's along with receiving Iowa's first National AIA Top Ten Green Buildings award in 2002. He has served as the design leader of multidisciplinary teams on several notable projects in Iowa, including the award-winning renovation of the American Enterprise Group National Headquarters, the Lutheran Church of Hope in Ankeny, and the Seamans Center for Engineering Arts and Sciences – South Annex Addition at the University of Iowa. Kevin's body of work has received more than 40 state, regional, and national AIA design awards.

In 2008, Kevin was awarded the ISU College of Design's Design Achievement Award in recognition for substantial contribution to the discipline of architecture. In 2017, Kevin received the AIA Iowa Medal of Honor, the highest recognition bestowed upon an individual from the AIA Iowa chapter, for his continued contributions to the profession and leadership in sustainable design.

Prior to joining BNIM in 2011, Kevin served as director of the Iowa Energy Center, an energy research center at ISU focused on energy efficiency and renewable energy technologies. Kevin was the Founding Chair of the United States Green Building Council-Iowa chapter and has served on several boards and commissions, including the Iowa Environmental Council, AIA Iowa, and the Iowa Commission on Energy Efficiency Standards and Practices, among others. Kevin has also served as a lecturer (2003 – 2006, 2008, 2011, 2012) in the Department of Architecture / ISU College of Design, focused on multidisciplinary sustainable design.
